From the Pastor

Greetings!

As our Youth Ministry program moves into full swing, I ask our parents to support our Youth Ministry efforts for Middle and High School youth by encouraging our young people to be involved in our Sunday evening gatherings. Also, we are in the process of encouraging our High School Youth to sign up for the National Catholic Youth Conference in Indianapolis. Details are posted in the bulletin. We have limited space so don't procrastinate. The Parish will invest in half the expenditure for this worthwhile experience. See Johnny Sherfick, our Youth Minister, for additional information.

I would like to encourage all our married couples to consider participating in "Grace Marriage" which is a marriage enrichment program designed to help husbands and wives grow together. The program takes place four times a year in our parish hall, from 9am-1:30pm, and is facilitated by two of our married couples: Mark and Ashlyn Wathen and Evan and Kara Burch. The program is worth the investment! Consider this opportunity as a gift to yourself, your marriage, and your family. Details are posted in the bulletin.

Our Fall Picnic is scheduled for Sunday, Sept. 24th. We need Country Store items in abundance. You may drop off items at the office. Let's also make sure we are selling our picnic raffle tickets to benefit our Tuition Assistance program for St. Mary and Trinity. Once again, we have been blessed with a \$10,000. match which means that if we sale \$30,000. worth of raffle tickets, \$20,000. of the \$40,000 profit will benefit our tuition assistance fund. Go Angels! Go Raiders!

We continue to make progress on our parish cemetery expansion as funds allow. In a few weeks, a concrete road will be poured in the new section of the cemetery. Once the road is complete, volunteer parishioners will begin to map out plots. No plots will be for sale, in the new section of the cemetery, until we are nearly sold out in the present cemetery. We have over 100 plots left to sale. Once our cemetery fund grows again, we will complete our cemetery expansion with the construction of a pavilion to serve as a chapel. Speaking of the cemetery, I would like to draw attention to a new ministry that has begun. We had some folks sign-up, in the last stewardship appeal, to assist with the weekly care of the cemetery. Our cemetery looks nice, most of the time, but wind storms wreak havoc on the place. The list for weakly TLC is posted in the bulletin. Our schools are celebrating with our Grandparents. The pope, who is 86 years old, has been an advocate for the dignity of the aging and has often emphasized the important role of grandparents in passing on the Catholic faith. He established the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021. Caring for grandparents and the elderly is not only a duty of gratitude and affection, but a necessity for building a more humane society. The third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly has the theme "His mercy is from age to age" (Lk. 1:50). God's mercy is manifested in history through the testimonies of those who have experienced it and passed it on to their children and grandchildren. Grandparents and the elderly are called to carry this mercy, to tell through words and life how God has been faithful to His promises and how He continues to love His people. Our grandparents and the elderly are also called to receive God's mercy and to allow themselves to be comforted by His Fatherly love that never abandons them. Between the two generations of the young and the elderly there is a communion of life and faith, a mutual giving and gratitude, a witness of hope and charity. Stewardship Bulletin Reflection

September 10, 2023

Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings are all about relationships. Among the many lessons we have learned from the global pandemic is the deep importance of the relationships and communities in our lives. Our families, neighbors, friends and parish family need us, and we need them to be our best selves.

St. Paul gives us simple instruction in our second reading from Romans to guide us in our dealings with others, reminding us what Christ Himself taught: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love is the overarching principal that guides us to be good stewards of our relationships.

In our Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus further refines this instruction on good stewardship of our relationships, even when they involve conflict. He says, "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother."

Jesus teaches us to confront the offending person directly and discretely — with the goal of restoring the relationship if possible. This is how we steward our relationships even through rocky waters. Jesus also speaks to us of the power and beauty of community life. "If two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Christian stewards, God has designed us in such a way that we must help each other on the journey towards heaven. Let us take care to steward our relationships well.
