Greetings!

Our Awakening ministry is our parish's outreach to inactive Catholics. We're asking everyone to take an invitation and gift it to those you know are inactive in the faith and need an invitation or welcome back to practicing the faith in the life of the Church. We have a team of parishioners who are trained and ready to facilitate a process of welcome and return to the Church. The Awakening ministry begins Thurs., Oct. 3rd at 6pm in the Activity Room of the Parish Hall.

With some prudence, Catholics can benefit spiritually from the messages and spiritual practices associated with the alleged apparitions of Mary in Medjugorje said the Vatican Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith. "This does not imply a declaration of the supernatural character of the phenomenon," nor does it mean that the tens of thousands of alleged messages from Mary published by the supposed "seers" are authentic, the dicastery said. With the approval of Pope Francis, the dicastery did, however, recognize "the abundant and widespread fruits, which are so beautiful and positive," associated with devotion to Mary, Queen of Peace, and with pilgrimages to Medjugorje.

Since 2013, Frank and Connie Hagan have lead the charge of overseeing our parish's Outreach ministry. While continuing to enjoy their ministry at the Daniel Pitino Shelter, they have asked to be relieved of their responsibility as Co-Chairs of the Outreach Committee. This Committee was one of the fruits of the 2013 Long Range Plan and so I want to publicly thank Frank an Connie for getting this Committee off the ground and running. In these eleven years, they have served the Committee so very well and we are grateful for their leadership and commitment. Well done, good and faithful servants! They are passing the baton on to Deacon Gayle and Ada Rhodes who have agreed to take the helm as Co-Chairs of the Outreach Committee. In this time of transition, please pray for these couples. Thanks to all who serve the parish through the Outreach Committee.
