II. Committee Reports

a. Finance – Father Brian on behalf of Corey Hall – We are a month and a half into the new budget, which is tight, but being closely monitored. \$27,102.79 in past due tuition from grade school; \$4,520.00 in past due tuition for Trinity.

b. Worship/Spiritual Life – Ashley Wright – New supplement books, more durable and child friendly, also includes new songs. Acts 2:42 small groups established, and Month of Remembrance preparations are being made.

c. Social Life – Britney Houston – Margaritas and Bunco was a success; making plans for Oct 4 ice cream social and blessing of animals immediately after school; Dec 8- Donuts with Santa; Jan 10- Bourbon and Bunco; Feb 8- World Marriage Day celebration after 4:00pm Mass.

d. Education/Formation – Cory Smith – Sonya Beyke new chair. 43 1st Communicants; 6 OCIA inquirers; Catholicism 101 podcast established with 11 episodes thus far, 668 downloads; Sep- Morality, Oct. The Occult; Grace Marriage cancelled due to lack of registrations. Made for More event was held end of last school year, 400 tickets sold, considering adding specific podcast episodes for Theology of the Body, Families of Faith- 40 families and 79 kids and will use Gospel weekly curriculum. Awakening, our ministry to Inactive Catholics, will begin this Fall. Young Adult ministry- Theology on Tap coming up; 28 Confirmation candidates, Youth ministry will split between high school and middle school groups. School update – seniors had retreat at Gasper. Ring Day Mass- Aug 28; Rainbow Mass- Sep 18. Virtue = Strength curriculum was discussed. Currently coaches are praying with teams, but students can also lead the teams in prayer. Current enrollment at schools: 103 at Trinity and 267 at SMWS.

e. Outreach – Christi Midkiff – Sept outreach goes to St Vincent de Paul; need participants for Pitino teams; all other outreach going smoothly, Birthright, Crossroads, St Gerard, Buddy Bags, Cards of Care. Deacon assigned will oversee outreach, so this transition will begin after the Appointment is effective.

f. Steering Committee – Terra's notes reviewed. Rendering of new plan reviewed. We will be able to begin the second round of Capital Campaign pledges while construction is ongoing.
