As announced, the Bishop, upon recommendation from the Diocesan Building Committee, has approved the expenditure of Phase 1 of our construction project to build a new school. Hooray for us! A reminder that the Phase 1 expenditure of \$11.2 Million includes the full finished exterior of the entire building, everything all enclosed under one roof, and the interior of the SMWS side completed including the spaces to be shared with THS like the cafeteria, media center/storm shelter, admin offices, etc. Also included in that figure is the full finished site work. A reminder that Phase 2 would then consist of finishing the interior of the THS side of the building and finishing the interior of the gym and auditorium, and any additional/final site work. Phase 2 would be at a total cost of \$5.7 Million. Dirt work is in progress and this will include the installation of a new storm drain and sewer.

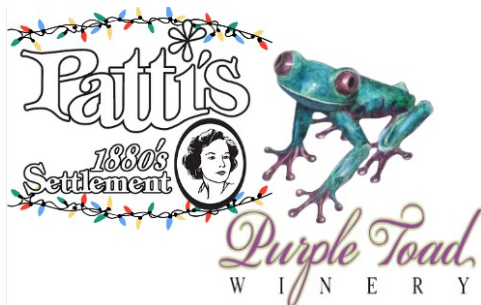

II. Steering Committee - Terra Knight

- a. We met with the Diocesan Building Committee. Overall, they are very supportive and excited. Axiom is fine tuning construction plans and then we'll proceed with bid interviews. The Diocese requires 2-3 bids. Axiom has included construction administration in their bid, which supports oversight of the project to manage expectation and cost.

III. Review Minutes

IV. New Business

- a. Staff Christmas Party- Fri., Dec. 6 at 5pm- School and parish councils to provide appetizers; Meal to be prepared and served with sides and desserts donated.

V. Committee Reports

A. Finance- Corey Hall

- a. We are agreeing on a settlement with Catholic Mutual on the roof damage to the Church. We are obtaining bids for this replacement, which will be covered by Catholic Mutual once agreement has been reached. The cost for refabricating the tower will be paid by the parish.
- b. It has been proposed that, while the church roof is being replaced, that we take advantage of the opportunity to replace the old HVAC system at an estimated cost of \$112,000.00. If not done the period of the roof replacement, then it would likely cost the parish much more in the future. The parish council agreed on this course of action.
- c. PTO purchased a new mini bus for St. Mary, and the decision was made to assign the expenses to St. Mary instead of Trinity, which is where the other buses are currently assigned.
- d. Monthly reports for September were reviewed and approved. \$34K positive for St. Mary, \$249K positive for Trinity, Horn Center was \$89K positive, and St Mary Cemetery \$13K positive.
