From the Pastor

Parishes are asked, each year, to conduct a monthly Mass count in September. Our parish averaged an 84% Mass attendance, of its members, throughout the month. Hats off to the majority of our parish who take care to keep holy the Sabbath day! Congratulations to the parish! Well done, good and faithful servants!

In September, we celebrated our 11th Anniversary of Perpetual Adoration in the parish. Since September of 2023, adorers have prayed 10,255 hours of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. Since 2013, our adorers have prayed a total of 111,055 hours of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. This provides me an opportunity to thank our Adoration coordinators: Majella Mills, Sharon Boarman, Dottie Pogue, Hope Brey, and Sandy Merritt. Congratulations to the parish! Well done, good and faithful servants!

As announced, the Bishop, upon recommendation from the Diocesan Building Committee, has approved the expenditure of Phase 1 of our construction project to build a new school. Hooray for us! A reminder that the Phase 1 expenditure of \$11.2 Million includes the full finished exterior of the entire building, everything all enclosed under one roof, and the interior of the SMWS side completed including the spaces to be shared with THS like the cafeteria, media center/storm shelter, admin offices, etc. Also included in that figure is the full finished site work. A reminder that Phase 2 would then consist of finishing the interior of the THS side of the building and finishing the interior of the gym and auditorium, and any additional/final site work. Phase 2 would be at a total cost of \$5.7 Million. Dirt work is in progress and this will include the installation of a new storm drain and sewer.

Responsible citizenship is a virtue and participation in political life is a moral obligation.
