School Happenings:

A Jubilee Year is traditionally proclaimed by the Universal Church every 25 years. It’s a particular year set aside to encourage the faithful to embark on pilgrimages, to repent of their sins and forgive the sins of others, and to renew a focus on the spiritual life. In the Hebrew tradition, as recorded in the Book of Leviticus, a Jubilee was celebrated every 50 years with the freeing of slaves and the forgiveness of debts. In 1300, Pope Boniface VIII instituted the first Christian Jubilee, and since then the Church has designated each new Jubilee as a special year of grace and forgiveness, offering the faithful an opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence. The New Year, 2025, is a Jubilee Year!

In the Diocese of Owensboro, to embrace our spirit in “Pilgrimage of Hope” for this Jubilee year, we have created a list of pilgrimage sites around our Diocese where one can gain an indulgence: St Stephen Cathedral, Owensboro; St. Romuald, Hardinsburg; St. Leo, Murray; St. Francis de Sales, Paducah; Marian Shrine, Bowling Green; Holy Redeemer, Beaver Dam. At these designated locations, you will find a passport booklet to be stamped at each location, along with prayer cards and scavenger hunts for children to also be able to participate.

A plenary indulgence may be gained once daily by each member of the faithful who, renouncing any personal attachment to sin, even venial sin, and desiring to obtain the indulgence, makes a pilgrimage to any of the 6 pilgrimage sites during the Jubilee Year and fulfills the following conditions: makes a sacramental confession while on pilgrimage or within a few days before or after; participates at Mass and receives Holy Communion at pilgrimage site; offers one Our Father and one Hail Mary or any other prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father; while on pilgrimage, devoutly assists at a liturgical celebration or other pious exercise (e.g. stations of the cross, rosary), or spends time in pious meditation ending with the Lord’s Prayer, the Apostles Creed or the Nicene Creed, and prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Consider making a pilgrimage, this Jubilee Year, as a family or as an organized group and faithfully follow the directions for receiving the plenary indulgence.
