From the Pastor

I enjoyed our celebration of Catholic Schools Week. Catholic schools afford the fullest and best opportunity to realize the fourfold purpose of Christian education, namely, to provide an atmosphere in which the Gospel message is proclaimed, community in Christ is experienced, service is the norm, and thanksgiving and worship of God is cultivated. The vitality of the Church is inextricably linked to the health of its Catholic schools because they provide the most effective way to evangelize and form holy men and women who make God known, loved, and served. Catholic schools continue to play a vital role in American civic life as they exemplify how to prepare citizens for engagement in democracy and a commitment to the common good. There's no substitute for spending 35 hours a week in an educational environment permeated by faith and Gospel values.

Over the past few weeks, I've been preaching about a few things that I've invited you to prayerfully consider for your spiritual life and growth in holiness: to participate, as a family, in going to confession; to embrace every Friday as a penitential day of prayer, abstinence, and fasting; to consider setting aside time, through the week, to make a visit to the Church for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament; and to consider daily Mass options through the week on your day off or if you are retired and have even more freedom to attend daily Mass through the week—8am and 12:05pm at St. Mary. All of this stems from the need to be more prayerful and to be intentional about our growth in holiness.

Two Diocesan gatherings are scheduled for next Saturday: A Catholic Men's conference at the RiverPark Center beginning at 9:30am and a Catholic Women's retreat at St. Ann Catholic Church in Morganfield beginning at 9am. To register, please use the QR code posted in the bulletin.


